THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED TO THE CLASS OF 2020

- In 2020, St. James School will graduate 65 students. These students will go on to further their education in high school.
- 30% of our students earned a score of 90th percentile or better nationally on the high school entrance exam. 12 students scored in the 95th percentile or better.

- 66% of the graduating class was offered scholarship funds.
- 13 students were offered scholarships to Mercy McAuley High School.
